

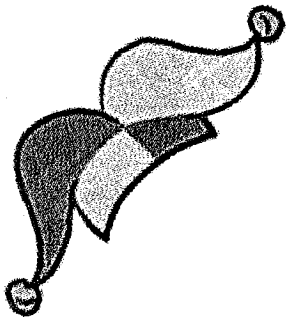

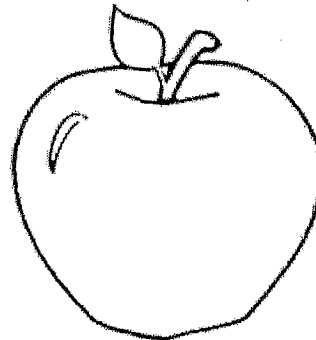

the month will be red.

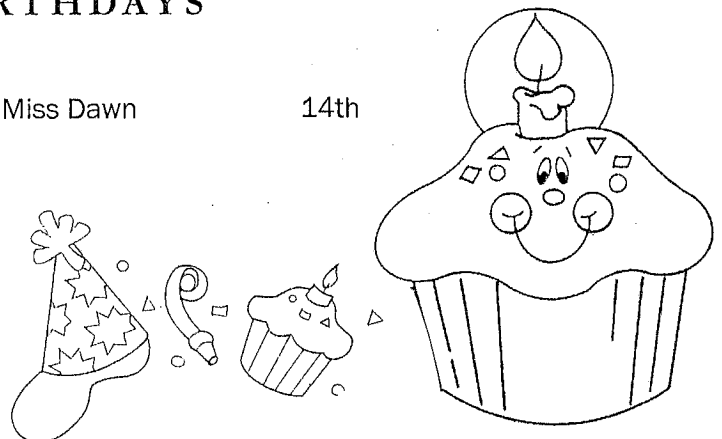

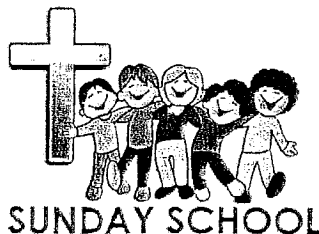
## CUBBIE CHECK
