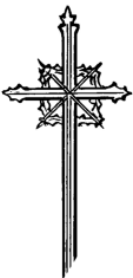


# HE IS RISEN INDEED! ALLELUIA!

**NICENE CREED**

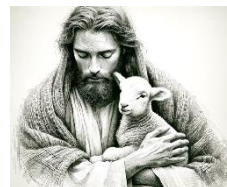
